

2022 Merit-based Incentive Payment System (MIPS) Quality Performance Category Data Validation Information

This memo provides information to users looking for information related to the 2022 Quality performance category data validation criteria.

For the 2022 performance period, please refer to the quality measure specifications and corresponding supporting documents within a collection type for the criteria used to determine the appropriate patient population (denominator) and quality action (numerator) for each selected quality measure. The measure specifications and supporting documents are the best resource to use to validate data related to each quality measure.

Supportive medical record and coding (Healthcare Common Procedure Coding System [HCPCS], Current Procedural Terminology [CPT], International Classification of Diseases, Tenth Revision [ICD-10], etc.) documentation may be requested by Centers for Medicare & Medicaid Services (CMS) to support data validation. Applicable coding for each measure is provided in the 2022 Medicare Part B Claims Measure Specifications, Clinical Quality Measure (CQM) Specifications, eCQM Specifications, CMS Web Interface Measure Specifications, and support documents.
