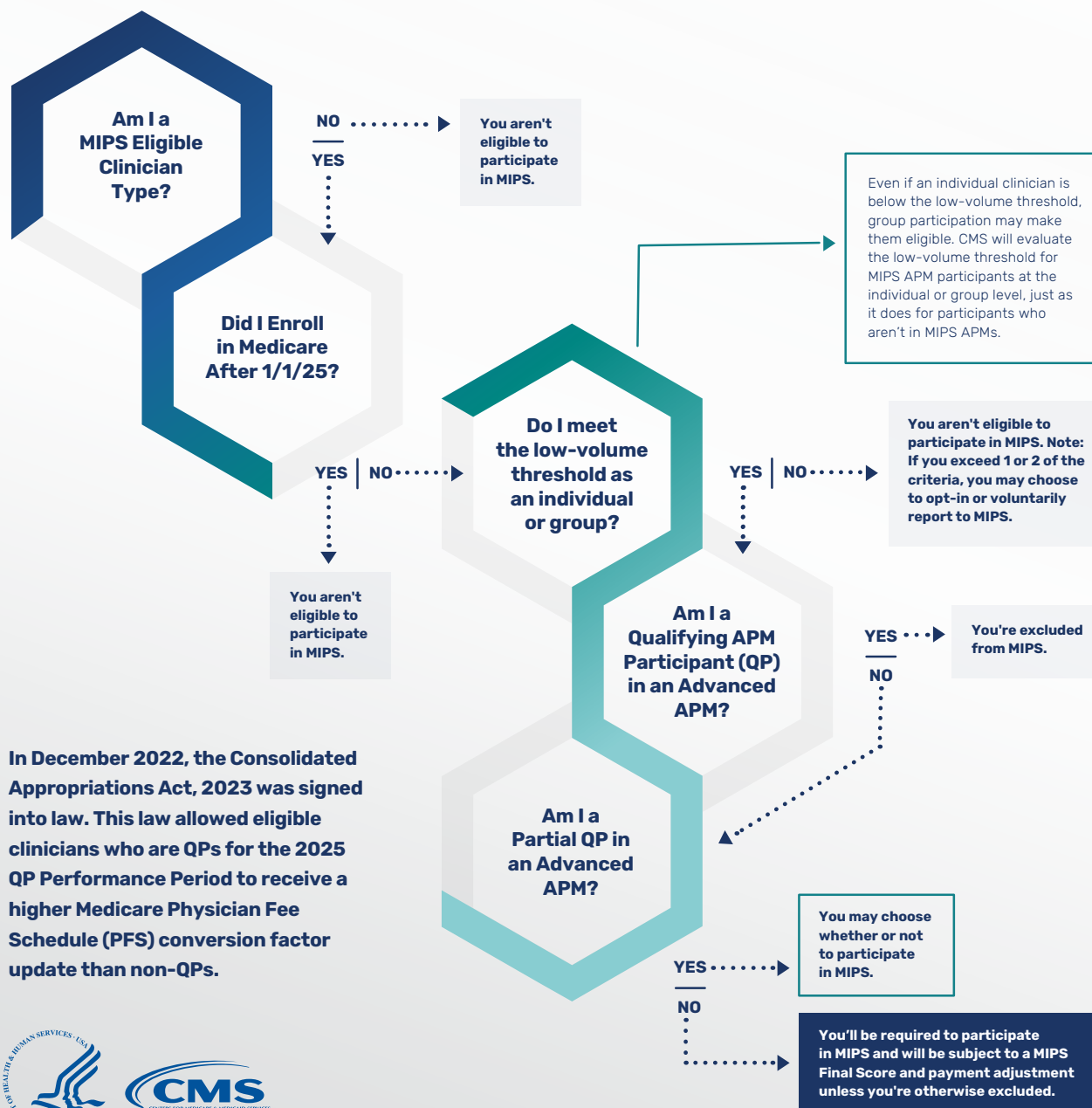


2025 MIPS Eligibility Decision Tree

Am I Eligible to Participate in the Merit-based Incentive Payment System (MIPS) in the 2025 Performance Year?



In December 2022, the Consolidated Appropriations Act, 2023 was signed into law. This law allowed eligible clinicians who are QPs for the 2025 QP Performance Period to receive a higher Medicare Physician Fee Schedule (PFS) conversion factor update than non-QPs.

MIPS eligible clinician types:

Physicians (includes doctors of medicine, osteopathy, dental surgery, dental medicine, podiatric medicine, and optometry), Osteopathic Practitioners, Chiropractors, Physician Assistants, Nurse Practitioners, Clinical Nurse Specialists, Certified Registered Nurse Anesthetists, Clinical Psychologists, Physical Therapists, Occupational Therapists, Qualified Speech-Language Pathologists, Qualified Audiologists, Registered Dietitians or Nutrition Professionals, Clinical Social Workers, Certified Nurse Midwives, groups or virtual groups that include one or more of these MIPS eligible clinician types.

Low-Volume Threshold Criteria for 2025:

- Bill more than \$90,000 for Part B-covered professional services under the Physician Fee Schedule; AND
- See more than 200 Medicare Part B patients; AND
- Provide more than 200 covered professional services to Medicare Part B patients

To achieve QP status in 2025, you must:

- Receive at least 75% of Medicare Part B payments through an Advanced APM Entity; OR
- See at least 50% of Medicare patients through an Advanced APM Entity.

To achieve partial QP status in 2025, you must:

- Receive at least 50% of Medicare Part B payments through an Advanced APM Entity; OR
- See at least 35% of Medicare patients through an Advanced APM Entity.
